PHASE 1A

Currently eligible to schedule:

- ✓ Healthcare personnel
- ✓ Long term care facility residents
- ✓ Medical first responders

PHASE 1B

Currently eligible to schedule:

- ✓ Individuals 75 and older

Scheduling soon:

- ✓ Individuals between the ages of 65 and 74

SCHEDULING COVID-19 VACCINATION

Vaccine Administration Management System (VAMS):

Appointments currently available at participating locations. Please visit the following link to access the VAMS portal: <https://dphsubmissions.ct.gov/OnlineVaccine>

- Online scheduling portal that allows individuals with an email address to create an account, log in, and search for a vaccine clinic
